The **Twitter** integration provides the your twitter handle in the Social Shares that are available in the Event Page and in Crowdfunding and Peer-to-Peer Fundraising.



When your supporters click on the social share icons on these pages, they share out to their audiences the message you craft. For Twitter, that default message includes your organization's short name, set in Settings > Organization, and your organization's Twitter handle.



To set the Twitter account to your handle, you can set it in the **Integrations** category of your Account **Settings**:
