

Can I choose types of credit cards to accept?

By default, your GiveSmart Fundraise forms will accept any major credit card. But there are cases where you may have an exclusive deal with one company, such as Visa, or you may not want to accept a specific type, like Diner's or Amex. In these cases you would want to limit the types of credit cards you will accept.

If you deselect one or more of the four major credit card types (Visa, Mastercard, American Express, Discover), the icons for those credit cards will disappear from your form (and your supporters won't be able to use them).
